From I-91 North: Take Exit 27 to Route 2 East for 8 miles. Turn Left on to Route 63 North for 2 miles. Northfield Mountain is on the right.

From I-91 South: Take Exit 28. Turn Left on to Route 10 North for 5 miles. Turn Right on to Route 63 South for 5 miles. Northfield Mountain is on the left.

From East: Take Route 2 West. Approximately 6.5 miles after the Erving Paper Mill, take Right on to Route 63 North. Follow Route 63 for 2 miles. Northfield Mountain is on the right.
